Project Description	The project revives an ancient craft as old as the town, where the people, most of whom were herders of livestock made their cloths and carpets out of their wool.

Needs assessment	<i>The town of Aarsal is known to raise livestock (estimated livestock in Aarsal today is 35 thousand heads of sheep), so it is only natural that their wool production will be used to help the local economy.</i>
Project Outcomes	<i>The project will help herders' wool producers, the project will also help the girls and women working on carpet weaving make money to support their families.</i>
Project Indicators	<i>The main indicator will show in the continuity of work for many girls and women and providing them with an opportunity to live stay in their village.</i>
Project Sustainability	<i>The Al-Mouna Rural Association- Crafts and Heritage has been in place for four years now and work is ongoing but as Aarsal is located at 1400 meters from sea level work stops for half the year, we need to improve the condition of the workshop in terms of heating by wood cladding the wall and installing a good heating system so that work can be done throughout the year.</i>
